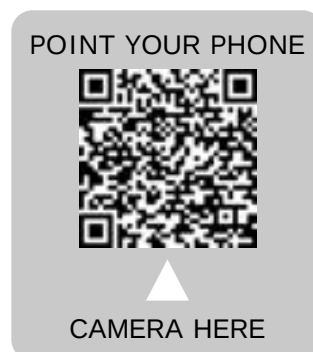

5.3 Superintendent Report:

Discussion:

Superintendent Paturel reported on enrollment - 42 8th graders are exiting this year. There were 7 TK students this year. Next year's enrollment is up to 19 already. Required ratio of one adult to every 10 TK students.

Mr. Paturel reported that he is meeting with teachers tomorrow for a discussion and input surrounding discipline.

Mr. Paturel also reported that he had reached out to other Superintendents in the county about schools that have a positive model that is effective with culture, climate and discipline. He visited two - Green Valley Elementary and Edwin Markham Middle Schools. Both schools had lots to share and some very interesting ideas and processes. He will be penciling out some goals in this area with staff.
